

## **Performing Arts Scholarship**

### **Nature:**

Music or Drama Excellence. The recipient must be an outstanding performer within their chosen field. They will have experience performing at a high level either as a soloist or in a recognised group/ensemble. They must show a strong commitment to his/her performing arts field. He/she will be able to detail achievements in their chosen genre.

### **Application:**

The applicant must:

- register online for the Performing Arts Scholarship and pay the registration fee (\$50)
- submit a Trinity Anglican College Performing Arts Scholarship online application form by the closing date
- submit a letter of introduction **and** a detailed curriculum vitae addressing the criteria
- submit a mid-year and yearly school report from the previous year
- be prepared to attend an audition and a scholarship interview, at which a Portfolio of Evidence in support of the application will be presented and discussed.

The success of applicants will be based on their ability in performing arts, written application and their audition and interview.

### **Tenure:**

Available to students entering Years 7,8, 9, 10 or 11 in 2022. Tenable for remaining years at Trinity Anglican College if scholarship criteria are maintained. (An annual review is conducted on all scholarship holders.)

### **Value:**

15-40% remission of tuition fees for remaining years at Trinity Anglican College.

### **Criteria**

Criteria and evidence required for award:

- Demonstrated academic commitment (i.e. school reports)
- Demonstrated achievement in chosen performance field, at school or within the community (i.e. awards/certificates/selections received)
- Students in Years 9-12 should be taking at least one of these subjects (Drama and/or Music) as an elective
- Personal qualities (school reports or references)
  - Honesty
  - Trustworthiness
  - Punctuality
  - Cooperation
  - Commitment
- Ongoing commitment to the performance co-curricular program at Trinity Anglican College.
