

Citizenship and Service Scholarship

Nature:

The recipient need not necessarily be an outstanding academic, but must show a strong commitment to his/her studies. He/she will be able to detail achievements in areas outside and/or inside the academic program that clearly demonstrate outstanding citizenship and/or service.

Application:

The applicant must:

- register online for the Citizenship and Service Scholarship and pay the registration fee (\$50)
- submit a Trinity Anglican College Citizenship and Service Scholarship online application form by the closing date
- submit a letter of introduction **and** a detailed curriculum vitae addressing the criteria
- submit a mid year and yearly school report from the previous year
- be prepared to attend a scholarship interview, at which a Portfolio of Evidence in support of the application will be presented and discussed.

The success of applicants will be based on their capacity to meet the criteria, their written application and their interview.

Tenure:

Available to students entering Years 7, 8, 9, 10 or 11 in 2022. Tenable for remaining years at Trinity Anglican College if scholarship criteria are maintained. (An annual review is conducted on all scholarship holders.)

Value:

15-40% remission of tuition fees

Criteria

Criteria and (evidence) required for award:

- Demonstrated academic commitment (i.e. school reports)
- Demonstrated history of achievement at school or in the community (i.e. awards or certificates received)
- Personal qualities (i.e. school reports or references)
 - Honesty
 - Trustworthiness
 - Punctuality
 - Cooperation
 - Commitment
- Ability to contribute to the co-curricular program at Trinity Anglican College
- Proven record of ongoing commitment and contribution to community events and activities.
