Dear Parents and Guardians

Thank you for the positive feedback about the introduction of the College Blazer for students in Years 7-9 and as an optional item for Junior School students from 2019. It is exciting to be bringing the quality of the uniform in line with what is appropriate for a school of our calibre.

A number of parents have expressed concern about the phasing out of the hoodie from Term 2, 2019. We always appreciate feedback; I hope I can allay some of those concerns in this letter.

Firstly, we are thoroughly committed to students being warm in winter. Our classrooms and learning spaces are heated. For senior students, the current tracksuit top jacket is adequate to keep a student warm for the duration of their PDHPE lesson. They do not stay in their sports uniform for the entire day. As for Junior students, we are already exploring ways to improve our sportswear options for Term 2, 2019. We will ensure that every Junior student is catered for.

I appreciate that some parents may not have bought a hoodie this year if they had known we would phase them out in Term 2, 2019. If you have purchased a hoodie this year and would like a full refund, we are happy to oblige. Just bring your hoodie and proof of purchase to the Uniform Shop before 30 June 2018 for a refund. If you choose to retain your hoodie, it is still part of our sports uniform until Term 2 2019 and, even after that date, able to be worn for after-school sporting activities and school camps.

I would ask for you to be patient with us during this time of improvement. The calibre of the Trinity uniform has been slipping in recent years and it is time to sharpen things up for the future. Trinity students enjoy an outstanding, high-quality education – it is important that our school uniform reflect that.
